Counting

Match the number to the amount.



Step 4

In this small step, children will **notice number symbols as labels**. Label buckets with numerals
(number symbols) 1, 2 and 3 and encourage children
to collect the corresponding number of beanbags for
each bucket.



Encourage children to count, using 1-to-1 correspondence, to check how many they have collected before they put them in the bucket.


Pencil Control


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

















Wrap up warm, and keep practising putting on your hat and coat independently!
